



Current and Future Plans

Although 140 years old, Colonna's Shipyard has not stood still with respect to modernization. Colonna's has made the capital investments necessary for improvements in efficiency and productivity.

Examples of modernization and improvement projects representing over 25 million dollar investment over the past five years are as follows:

- Purchased the nation's largest Marine Travelift (1,000 Metric Ton Lifting Capacity) in 2011 and started operation in West Yard facility in 2012.
- Expansion of area footprint from sixty to over 100 acres.
- Doubling the size of the fabrication facility to over 33,000 square feet of heated area with 100 ton crane capacity and 40 ft. doors.
- "State of the Art" Machine Shop Facility with lathes, boring mills, shapers and planers capable of handling shafts up to 150 ft. long with a 40 inch swing and weighing up to 120 tons.
- Adding two customer dedicated office facilities (West Yard at South Main Street and East Yard at 300 Indian River Road) including the capability to berth and mess over 40 people.

Colonna's Shipyard continues to plan for the future with the following planned improvements:

- Acquiring the property across the street from the main entrance which will add 25 acres for additional parking.
- Building an additional Floating Drydock (planned 2017). This will add an additional 51 jobs to the area.
