
1. George Lankford Colonna 1890-1890
Infant son and last child of Charles Jones Colonna 1849-1920 and Margaret Okeson Dunston Colonna 1859-1892 who are both buried here.
3. Margaret Warren Dunston 1890-1893
Died of typhoid malarial fever and had to be burned immediately. She is a niece to Margaret Okeson Dunston Colonna 1859-1892 and John James Dunston 1856-1891 who are both buried here.
8. John James Dunston 1856-1891
Died of fractured skull at a train depot. Brother of Margaret Okeson Dunston Colonna 1859-1892 and son of Margaret Willoughby Warren Dunston 1827-1872 who are both buried here.
9. Margaret Willoughby Warren Dunston 1827-1872
She is the mother of Margaret Okeson Dunston Colonna 1859-1892 and the mother of John James Dunston 1856-1891 who are both buried here.
12. Charles Jones Colonna 1849-1920
Owner and founder of Colonna's Shipyard 1875. Died at his home, 801 Colonial Avenue, Norfolk from kidney failure due to having sugar diabetes. Charles has two wives and two sons buried here.

Second Wife - Fannie Fentress Cornick Colonna 1878-1950.
Son - George Lankford Colonna (infant) 1890-1890.
Mother - Margaret O. Colonna

13. Margaret Okeson Dunston Colonna 1859-1892
Died of pneumonia from being caught in a summer rain storm while crabbing on the Campostella Bridge with a friend. Margaret has a husband, mother, brother and son buried here.
Husband - Charles J. Colonna 1849-1920
Mother - Margaret Willoughby Warren Dunston 1827-1872
Brother - John James Dunston 1856-1891
Son - George Lankford Colonna (Infant) 1890-1890
17. Bruce Cornick Colonna 1903-1949
Died at home from a heart attack. Bruce has a mother, father and wife buried here.
Mother - Fannie F. Colonna 1878-1950
Father - Charles J. Colonna 1849-1920
Wife - Lucy M. Colonna 1912-1987
11. Fannie Fentress Colonna 1878-1950
Died of a heart attack at home.
Fannie has a husband and son buried here.
Husband - Second wife of Charles J. Colonna 1849-1920
Son - Bruce C. Colonna 1903-1949
18. Lucy Miller Colonna 1912-1987
Died of breast cancer.
Lucy is buried beside her husband Bruce C. Colonna 1903-1949

NOTE: Part of the above Dunston family is buried across Princess Anne Road in Cedar Grove Cemetery. Jacob Bryan Dunston 1814-1883 is buried next to his daughter, Mary A. Dunston, with his first wife, Mary Hart Dunston, next to her.

Jacob was the husband of Margaret Willoughby Warren Dunston 1827-1872, his second wife, the father of Margaret Okeson Dunston Colonna 1859-1892 and the father of John James Dunston 1856-1891, who are buried in the Charles J. Colonna plot - Elmwood Cemetery.


